He is widely recorded and tours on the national and international jazz circuits. Sullivan has played alongside Jazz icons including Charlie Parker, Lester Young, Roy Eldridge, Art Blakey, Red Rodney, Jaco Pastorius and Pat Metheny. A five-time

Grammy nominee, he serves as a panelist for the National Endowment for the Arts, and as a clinician, lecturer, and adjudicator in jazz workshops at universities and schools across the country and abroad. Featured guests for this concert will include extraordinary pianist, Michael Gerber, and bass flutist, Marc Berner.
